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BIOGRAPHY

Anastasia Petriaeva is a practicing watercolor artist, recognized for her atmospheric landscape and "landscape-state" works. She is a participant and award winner in numerous international watercolor exhibitions and competitions. Her practice focuses on capturing the positive, sublime emotions evoked by the contemplation of nature.

Born in Russia in 1992, Anastasia graduated with honors from the Academy of Architecture and Art with a degree in Industrial Design. She is an International Cultural Ambassador for the Canadian paint brand Rockwell Art and and the Korean paint brand Herend. Her original works are held in private collections across Russia, Canada, USA, UK, Netherlands, Germany, China, Australia, and other countries.

She is also the author of popular educational video courses on watercolor techniques, which are studied by watercolor enthusiasts globally and have been translated into several languages.

ARTIST STATEMENT

In my watercolor landscapes, I strive to capture images of nature that evoke bright, positive, and sometimes sublime emotional states. I romanticize the culminating moments of natural contemplation—the breathtaking color of turquoise water, the pure delight of gazing at iridescent stones beneath a clear surface.

I view the ability to admire nature as a fundamental aspect of human essence. My work explores the continuity of generations who have, and will continue to, admire similar phenomena, such as the play of light in the clouds or the transparency of water. This connection serves as an anchor, reconnecting us to our true selves.

My goal is to offer the viewer a moment to slow down and find a harmonious, uplifting state, a respite from the stress of modern life. I approach watercolor as a form of meditation for both the artist and the viewer, focusing on the positive impact of water imagery. Technically, I utilize the expressive capabilities of modern watercolor while paying special attention to the physical and optical laws governing the depiction of water, including reflections, refractions, and transparency.
